## About the fund

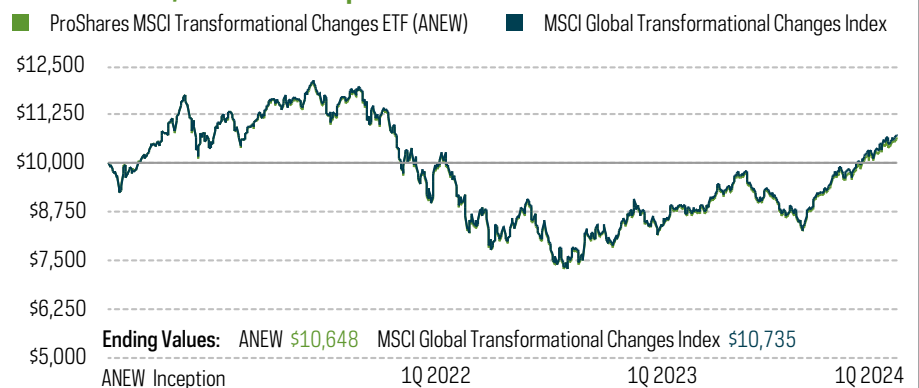

## Growth of \$10,000 since inception<sup>2</sup>


