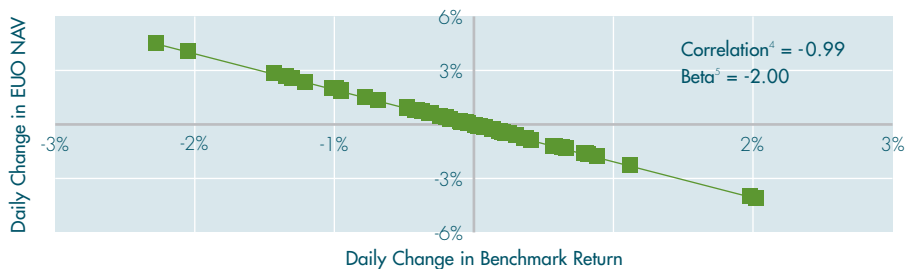
FUND PERFORMANCE AND BENCHMARK HISTORY

ProShares UltraShort Euro seeks a return that is -2x the return of a benchmark (target) *for a single day*, as measured from one NAV calculation to the next. Due to the compounding of daily returns, returns over periods other than one day will likely differ in amount and possibly direction from the target return for the same period. These effects may be more pronounced in funds with larger or inverse multiples and in funds with volatile benchmarks. 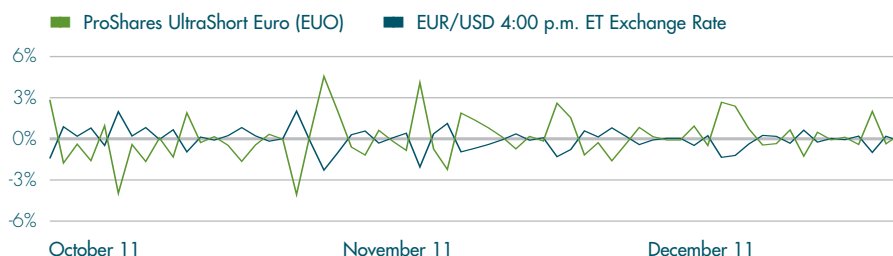

¹Since inception returns are annualized. Market returns are based on the composite closing price and do not represent the returns you would receive if you traded shares at other times. The first trading date is typically several days after the fund inception date. Therefore, NAV is used to calculate market returns prior to the first trade date. ²When the euro appreciates relative to the U.S. dollar, the EUR/USD exchange rate increases, and vice versa. The EUR/USD exchange rate is expressed as a rate that reflects the number of U.S. dollars that can be exchanged for one euro, as provided each day by Reuters. ³Expense ratio does not include brokerage commissions and related fees paid by the fund. ⁴Correlation is a measure of the strength and direction of a linear relationship between two variables. ⁵Beta is a measure of the slope, which is the steepness of the line drawn through the fund return vs. the benchmark return on a daily basis.

BENCHMARK DESCRIPTION

The euro benchmark is the 4 p.m. ET euro in U.S. dollar terms (EUR/USD cross rate) as provided by Reuters. The EUR/USD cross rate is expressed as a rate that reflects the number of U.S. dollars that can be exchanged for one euro.

BENCHMARK CHARACTERISTICS

Quarterly Benchmark Volatility⁶ 12.37%

⁶The quarterly volatility refers to annualized standard deviation, a statistical measure that captures the variation of a benchmark's returns from their mean and that is often used to quantify the risk of the benchmark over a specific time period. The higher the volatility, the more a benchmark's return fluctuates over time. This ETF invests substantially in financial instruments linked to the performance of currencies, such as swap agreements, forward contracts, and futures and options contracts, which may be subject to greater volatility than investments in traditional securities.
